

Cross-Registration Procedure for Non-CIA students:

Students from participating colleges (see list below) who are matriculated, full-time students in good standing, may take one course per semester during the academic year at the Cleveland Institute of Art as part of their full-time load (minimum of 12 credits at the home college and a maximum of 18 total credits including credits at CIA). Permission is granted by CIA on a **space**-available basis.

- Students seeking to cross-register at CIA must first determine the course for
 which they will cross-register. The course schedule by semester can be found at
 my.cia.edu, Department, Registrar or at this link <u>Course Search.</u> When searching for
 classes please make sure you are in the correct term and division (undergraduate) no
 other fields need to be filled in, you can then click search to get the complete
 schedule with every course.
- 2. CIA holds no formal admissions process for cross-registrants; however, the student must secure the permission of the CIA course instructor, which is listed in the course schedule. An email is best for this and this permission must be forwarded to the CIA Registrar's office (registrar@cia.edu) before or at the time of enrollment. - 3. Obtain permission from your home institution via the <u>cross-registration form</u>. A signed cross-registration form from them is needed to officially enrolled in a course.
- 4. Finally, the student must come IN-PERSON to CIA Registrar's office during CIA's Add/ Drop period—the week before the semester starts and the first week of the semester, to get enrolled in the course and pay the fees. Please email registrar@cia.edu to set up an appointment to come in our hours for cross-reg are M-F 9am-3pm.
- 5. Along with the course you are requesting to enroll in you will also be enrolled in a zero credit hour Safety Lab course. This course is a pre-requisite for all CIA courses and needs to be completed within the first few weeks of the semester. It is normally a one day course for couple of hours during the first few weeks. If the course is not completed you will be dropped from the CIA course.
- 6. At the time of enrollment, the student will be required to pay the CIA course registration fee, to confirm cost please contact Business Affairs businessaffairs@cia.edu.

NOTE: Students who do not enroll during the add/drop period and/or do not pay the registration fee at the time of enrollment will not be able to cross-register.
